**RULES FOR THE RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR PHARMACIST'S ASSISTANT AND PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION OF PHARMACIST'S ASSISTANTS: PHARMACY ACT, 2004**

In terms of section 67(2) of the Pharmacy Act, 2004 (Act No. 9 of 2004), it is made known that the Pharmacy Council of Namibia has under section 20(3) of that Act –

- (a) made the rules set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) withdrawn the rules published under General Notice No. 4 of 15 January 2013.

**SCHEDULE****Definitions**

**1.** In these rules, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression defined in the Act has that meaning, and –

“the Act” means the Pharmacy Act, 2004 (Act No. 9 of 2004).

**Recognition of qualification obtained in Namibia for registration as pharmacist assistant**

**2.** For section 20(3) of the Act, a qualification awarded by an educational institution in Namibia to a person after successful completion of a course of study and examination approved by the Council under section 16 of the Act as appropriate education, tuition or training for qualifying persons as pharmacist's assistants, is recognized as a qualification which entitles the holder thereof to be registered as a pharmacist's assistant under the Act.

**Application for registration as a pharmacist's assistant**

**3.** (1) An application for registration as a pharmacist's assistant in terms of section 20 of the Act must be submitted to the Council in the form determined and provided by the Council, and must be accompanied by –

- (a) evidence of compliance with the requirements for registration in terms of section 20(1)(a) or (2) of the Act or rule 2 of these rules; and
- (b) the appropriate registration application fee determined by the Council under section 28 of the Act.

(2) An applicant must provide any additional information or documents required by the Council for purpose of considering the application for registration within such time as may be stipulated by the Council.

(3) Before deciding an application, the Council, if deemed necessary, may require the applicant to demonstrate that he or she has an adequate understanding of the English language.

**Deciding application**

4. (1) After having considered the application and any documents or information submitted in accordance with rule 3, the Council must -

- (a) grant the application and register the applicant as pharmacist's assistant if the applicant satisfies the Council that he or she complies with the requirements for registration in terms of section 20(1)(a) or (2) of the Act or rule 2 of these rules; or
- (b) refuse to grant the application if the Council is not satisfied that the applicant is entitled to be so registered.

(2) The Council must, as soon as is practicable, inform the applicant in writing of the Council's decision in relation to the application, and -

- (a) if the application is granted, issue to the applicant a certificate of registration in the form determined by the Council and enter the name of the applicant in the appropriate register;
- (b) if the application is refused, specify the reasons for the refusal.

**Language of forms and documents**

5. Any form or document required to be submitted to the Council in terms of these rules must -

- (a) be in the English language; or
- (b) if it is not in English, be accompanied by a translation thereof into the English language.

- xi) under section 23(1)(e) amended the classification of a portion of main road 115 as described in Schedule XVIII and shown on sketch-map P2287 by the symbols A2-C1 to a portion of district road 3839;
- xii) under section 23(1)(e) amended the classification of a portion of main road 115 as described in Schedule XIX, shown by co-ordinates in Schedule XXVIII and indicated on sketch-map P2287 by the symbols D-E-F-F1-G-H to a portion of trunk road 14/1;
- xiii) under section 23(1)(e) amended the classification of a portion of main road 115 as described in Schedule XX and shown on sketch-map P2287 by the symbols H1-H2 to a portion of district road 3840;
